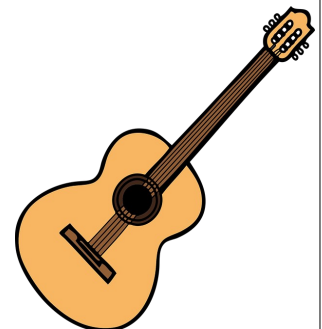


COVERACK SCHOOL—KARATE READING!
