

Reading Books

If your child is in Year 1, 2 or 3, we will be giving your child 2 reading books on a Monday and a library book. Please can they read these books at home from Monday to Thursday. Please bring back the books on a Friday. We can then swap the books and replace them with another reading book each week. This is a new system for this academic year - it will support the cleaning procedures/rules in place due to Covid, but it also gives your child a chance to read a book more than once. It is recommended that children read a book once for the purpose of decoding words (breaking a word up into sounds), twice for fluency (pace) of reading and a third time to comprehend (understand) what they have read and enjoy the book. **Please can your child therefore bring their book bag on Monday.**

REMINDER ABOUT ILLNESS AND ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

Please do not send your child to school if they **or any member of your family who shares a home with them**, have any of the following symptoms:

- A high temperature
- A new, continuous cough—this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual), ie not 3 single coughs.
- A loss or change to your sense or taste—this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal
